

Pet Owner Supply Checklist

Please remember to bring all needed supplies and food for your family members as well as your pets.

- **Food:** At least a three (3) day supply of pet food in an airtight container.
- **Water:** At least a three (3) day supply for each of your pets. Recommendation is one (1) gallon of water per day per pet.
- **Medications and Medical Records:** Keep an extra supply of your pet's medications in a watertight container.
- **Leash and collar with identification attached.** This includes the Collier County Pet License tag and ID Tag with your pet's name and owner contact information. Keep a backup leash and collar in your supplies kit.
- **Proof of Vaccination:** This is critical; only animals that are current on their vaccinations will be allowed in the Pet Friendly Shelter. Vaccination records should be stored in a watertight plastic bag. Include microchip information also.
- **Crate or Carrier:** Make sure your pet has a sturdy crate that is big enough for him to stand and turn around in. Be sure your crate is clearly marked with your last name written on or attached. Include your pet's favorite bedding and toys.
- **Sanitation:** Include disinfectants to keep your pet's living area clean. Use unscented bleach and plenty of paper towels. Bring plastic bags to provide for your pet's sanitation needs.
- **Pictures of You with Your Pet:** Keep pictures of you with your pet with you at all times. It is important that you be able to provide proof your pet belongs to you.
- **Identification for You:** It is important that you be able to identify who you are. Make sure you have a driver's license or some other form of picture ID on you at all times.
